

Can Moldova store electricity







Overview

In 2022 Moldova created, initially just for renewable power supplies, before Russia attacked Ukraine electricity system that resulted in electricity imports from Ukraine being suspended. provided Energocom with €300m to improve energy security. Energocom has become the central electricity supplier and public electricity trader of Moldova as well as a gas supplier.

Does Moldova need energy?

Moldova is almost totally dependent on fossil fuel and electricity imports, with natural gas serving most of its energy needs. The government plans to diversify the energy mix with renewables such as wind and solar.

How has Moldova restructured its electricity distribution network?

As part of the reforms, Moldova restructured and partially privatized its electricity distribution network, including Premier Energy, a private company that controls 70 percent of the country's electric distribution grid.

Does Moldova have a new energy policy?

Moldova has committed to implement reforms embedded within the European Union's Third Energy Package, a suite of legislation adopted in 2009 aimed at creating integrated and competitive energy markets for natural gas and electricity.

What happened to Moldova's electricity supply in 2022?

In November 2022 the power station located in Transnistra which produced electricity from Russian gas ceased supplying Moldova with electricity. Electricity was imported from Romania, albeit at a higher cost, helped by a grant from the EU of €200m.

Where does Moldova get its electricity from?

Moldavskaya GRES (MGRES) in the separatist region of Transnistria supplies the vast majority of the remaining 80 percent of electricity. Moldova also imports electricity from Ukraine and Romania. For years Moldova's natural gas



consumption almost exclusively relied on Russian gas imports.

What was Moldova's primary energy supply in 2018?

The primary energy supply in 2018 was about half natural gas, a quarter oil, and solid biomass at one-fifth. Renewable energy has expanded rapidly, and Moldova is seeking to diversify its energy sources and cease purchasing from Russia.



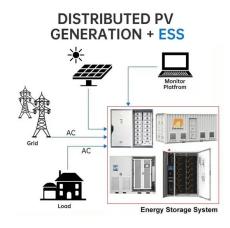

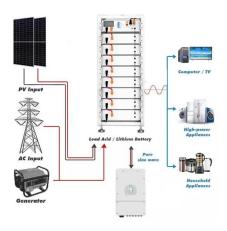
