Overview

If you take a scroll down the page, you will notice that most countries have a well-defined plug and voltage standard. Many Latin-American, African and Asian countries, however, use a motley collection of - often incompatible - plugs and sometimes also the voltage differs from region to region.

Which voltages are not included in a power supply?

Some applications use specialized higher voltages (such as 4160 V or 13,400 V) but these are on a more unique basis and typically involve transformers so those are not included.

How many outlets should a 230 volt power supply use?

Some countries with a voltage around 230 V use 10 A for regular usage and 15 or 16 A for high-power applications. In such cases, 15 and 16 A outlets may be much less common, since 10 A at 230 V already provides considerably more power than even the high-power (16 A) outlets in 120 V countries.



How many volts does an electric plug use?

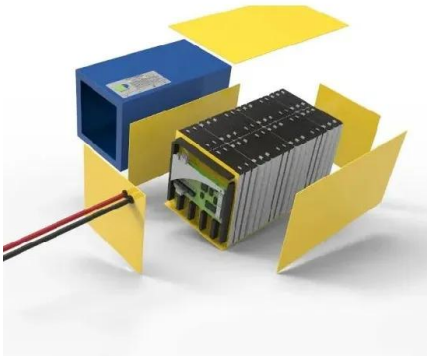
The table shows that in most countries the mains supply is between 220 and 240 volts (50 or 60 Hz); countries that operate on 100-127 volts are greatly outnumbered. The list also reveals that types A and C are the most frequently used electric plugs worldwide.

What is the mains voltage?

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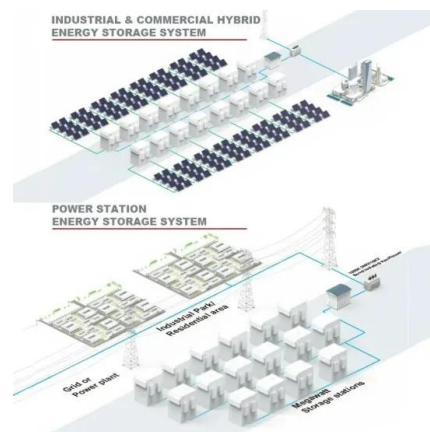

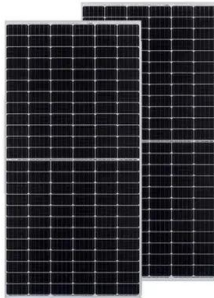

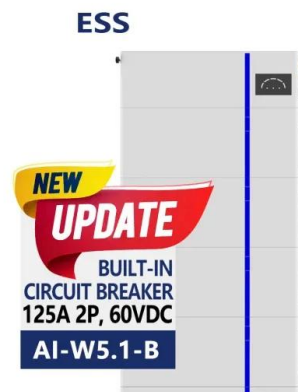
